## • Club Hubs update

The Club Hub complements other club activities.

As a Club Hub we liase with Croquet NSW and other Hubs to program activities such as coaching sessions, workshops, activities days, holding information sessions and running State events that can be held on two courts.

Shortly, the first of 4 payments of \$2,500 will be deposited in a dedicated Club Hub account. We plan to purchase a television to be mounted on the noticeboard wall. This can be used to complement coaching sessions. We have coaches in both golf and association

qcroquet who are able to use the excellent resource material produced by the Australian Croquet Academy.

The new Rules of Golf Croquet come into force in Australia on 1 July. We plan to use the video through the television (Warren sent the link to all members), together with referees and a whiteboard to explain the law changes.

Our first event will be introducing gateball. We will also invite members of the Coutts Crossing Croquet Club, another Club Hub, to join us for this event, which includes a sausage sizzle. Later we plan to run a similar day for the other MNCCC clubs. We can use money from our special account to cover the costs.
