Golf Croquet Coaching by Pam Wiemers

Pam has fairly recently moved to Port Macquarie from Toronto. She is a Level 2 Golf Croquet Coach and has very generously offered to run some coaching clinics. Initially, the first of 3 clinics will be from 9:00am to 11:00am on Mondays, starting on Monday 24 April. These clinics will be on Court 3: Clinic 1. Grip, Stalk, Stance, Swing; Clinic 2. Roquet, Stun shots; Clinic 3. Hoop running.

Pam envisages spending one hour on drills and finishing with a game that emphasises the skills practised.

Sign on sheets are on the tables beside the clubhouse door. The maximum number per course of 3 clinics is 6.
