Grants (Coordinator Robyn Richardson)

- On September 24, The Grants work group submitted a grant application to Pycon. The grant application was for lining and insulating the verandah of the clubhouse and adding 3 ceiling fans. Sadly, the submission was not successful.
- The club received a \$300 grant from Bunnings for the refurbishment of the gardens on the Buller Street side of the property.
- The Grants working group will be making a Grant application to the NSW State Government Sport and Clubs infrastructure grant which we expect to open on 4 November. This will be in accordance with the quote for repair and recladding with Hardie fibre cement and painting, as received from R J Macereth.
- o If you know of a need in the club or have ideas about how to meet that need there is a process that we all need to follow. That process involves either speaking to a committee member or writing down the idea and submitting it to a committee member. The committee will then discuss the submission. If the committee believes it's workable, this will then be passed to the Grants working group.

Grounds and Gardening Working Group (Coordinator Eric Drury)

Donations for Buller Street Garden upgrade:

Our Club has recently received vouchers to the amount of \$300 from Bunnings to be spent on upgrading the Buller Street Garden. This amount plus anonymous donations from Club members amounting to \$550 are greatly appreciated. The Grounds and Gardening Working Group will keep members informed as to when the project will commence.

Grooming of Courts:

Plans are underway for the Grounds Working Group to be assisting Shorty, our Greenkeeper, with grooming/scarifying the courts on a couple of Thursdays. This work will not interrupt play on other days, but should improve conditions of play.

Players have probably noticed the improvements of the courts now that they are again being regularly rolled. We thank Tony Croft for offering to do this.
