• Bookings on croquetbooking.com

It is good to see the increased numbers playing, particularly on Monday and Tuesday mornings. If there are already 16 people booked on courts 1 and 2 you may book on court 3. When the draw is done there are usually people who are happy to play on court 3. If not, those booked on court 3 will play there. If there is a withdrawal from courts 1 and 2 you may change your booking – add to courts 1 and 2 and delete your name from court 3.

Payment of Green Fees and Top-up facility

This is a two step process:

- deposit the money into our bank account (BSB 032 586 Account 249 968) either by direct deposit with G/Fees and your name as the reference or at the Westpac branch with your date of birth as the reference
- 2. log onto the Club Booking System and top up with the amount you banked and save the transaction.

If you have booked in and for some reason do not play then it is your responsibility to delete the booking prior to midnight otherwise you will be charged green fees for that day.

Bank deposits are reconciled with the top up record each month. Any queries please contact Treasurer Pam.

PRACTICE

You are asked to register in the Practice Book whenever you practice - you are no longer required to book in on the booking site. It is free when you are practising on your own. When playing a game with 2 or more people the normal lawn fee applies and you need to book in.
